
## Cover of The Month

It has been issued certificate #204377 by the APES - which describes the cover as "United States, Scott No. 158, 161 and 165, used on cover (probably a paste-up use on heavier contents) Applegate, Oreg., genuine, stamps and cover flawed." Nice higher denomination usage on a Oregon postal history cover.



# StampBuddy A New American Philatelic Society Program by Caroline Brandt

We were introduced to this new program through an excellent Power Point presentation by one of our members, Michael Bloom. He is the committee chair for the StampBuddy program

This new program debuted at the show in Milwaukee. stamp Wisconsin and will be present at PIPEX 2014. OSS is one of seven stamp clubs selected for this pilot program. Members of APS may apply for approval as mentors. Each makes a one mentor commitment to keep in contact and assist one or more Buddies with their new or renewed interest in philately. Mentors are also encouraged to introduce the hobby to potential

stamp collectors through presentations such as the one we viewed. The StampBuddy program is well defined in a brochure, service handbook and on the website (www.stamps.org/StampBuddy) Included in the handbook are: needs for the program, the service, roles and qualifications for Mentors and Buddies and outreach to the Non-collecting community. Buddy eligibility is age 18 years or older. Buddies must also be APS members, encouraged by an initial discounted membership. This program introduces new people into the hobby especially those interested in current events, history or geography. It affords an opportunity for social activity and learning. "If we do not exhibit, our collecting may have an audience of one: ourselves". We can share our enthusiasm, expertise and encourage another in his or her interests in their topic of interest. We encourage others to join Michael Bloom, Bill Seymour, Paul Malan and Win Bohme in becoming Mentors. Phil Kumler expressed interest in the program to involve parents of youth in the hobby.

# Feedback on your exhibit – the UEEF by - Sheryll Ruecker

PIPEX 2014 is getting closer, so now is the time to visit the APS website and download the latest copy of the *Manual of Philatelic* Judging to read before you start writing up your exhibit. While you are there, print off a copy of the "Uniform Exhibit Evaluation Form" (UEEF).

This form shows you what the judges will be looking for in your exhibit, and it has a breakdown of points allocated for each of the judging criteria which I covered in last year's article on "How to Build your Philatelic Exhibit."

These criteria again are:

- Treatment
- Importance
- Knowledge
- Personal Study and Research
- Rarity
- Condition
- Presentation

The judges will use this form as a guide when they are at the frames judging your exhibit, and they will add comments to it before returning it to you at the end of the show.

The aim of the UEEF is to provide you with **written feedback** to help you improve your exhibit and achieve your goals as an exhibitor.




